<u>DAY 1:</u> <u>Hanoi Arrival</u>

Xin Chao, Vietnam! Welcome to Hanoi. Hanoi is the exciting capital city of Vietnam, where old meets new. From the incredible French colonial architecture to the tantalizing Vietnamese cuisine, it is a city that will put all of your senses to good use.

Here, you will be received by our local guide at the Noi Bai International Airport. Later transfer to hotel.

<u>DAY 2:</u> <u>Hanoi City Tour — Visit Train Street (B)</u>

Post breakfast, head on to visit the **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum & One Pillar Pagoda**, an important place of pilgrimage for Vietnamese. Ho Chi Minh's House on Stilts, built in the style of Vietnam's ethnic minorities, surrounded by verdant and peaceful gardens.

Post Lunch, you will visit **Tran Quoc Pogoda**, one of the oldest pagoda in Hanoi. Even after relocating and repairing it several times, Tran Quoc pagoda still kept its own spirit and standstill with pride and honor. You can also admire West lake, the biggest lake in Hanoi from here.

Visit the iconic **Train Street** later today, where you can find trains zipping through a busy narrow market street as well as the Hanoi Cathedral.

Go walking to the Hanoi Old Quarters, where you can experience the daily life of locals in the oldest area of Ha Noi. Meals on your own. Overnight in Hanoi.







<u>DAY 3:</u> <u>Hanoi – Halong Bay Day Trip (B/L)</u>

Leave for Halong Bay early morning. **Halong Bay** is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and one of world's natural seven wonders.

Upon arrival, our boat awaits to take you through the bay. Along the way, the ship will stop at one of most beautiful limestone caves in the bay.

During your cruise on board, you can feast on some local Vietnamese seafood.

Post lunch on board, we will go caving, followed by kayaking across limestone islets in probably the most beautiful bay in the world.

Return to Hanoi. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 4:

Hanoi - Fly to Da Nang - Hoi An Eco Tour - Basket Boats - Da Nang (B/L)

After breakfast, transfer to Hanoi airport for a short flight to Da Nang city.

Upon arrival, visit the beautiful little ancient town of **Hoi An**.

We will cycle through peaceful green paddies to reach the local market (**Ba Le market**).

(If you can't cycle, the alternative options are available without any surcharge:) Get an hands on experience of the hustle and bustle trading lives of local people.

Upon arrival, you will have a break with a Vietnamese coffee to cool down and relax. Then, let's join a fun **bamboo basket boat** ride through small creeks in water coconut fields & the folk game "bit mat dap noi".

Cook a variety of local dishes with the help of our chef & Relish the cooked meal.

Post lunch, we will take a lazy boat back to Hoi An Ancient Town. Sit back and enjoy the scenery and local life of fisherman along the riverside.

Back to Dan Nang. Transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.



<u>DAY 5:</u> <u>Da Nang – Ba Na Hills – Golden Bridge (B)</u>

Today, we will visit the nearby **Ba Na Hills**, which is a mountaintop resort complex that looks like a medieval castle. Hop on to the world's longest cable car and stop at **Golden Bridge**(**Hand of God**). Have lunch by your own choices.

After lunch, you also get to enjoy theme park rides in **Fantasy Park**– the third biggest indoor games zone in Vietnam with a series of interesting games: 4 – 5D film, skiver, the death race, dinosaur Park.

In the evening, relax and soak in more of Da Nang's beautiful seas and maybe shop for famous souvenirs here.

DAY 6: Da Nang - Fly to Ho Chi Minh City - Half Day City Tour (B)

In the morning catch a quick flight from Da Nang to Ho Chi Minh city popularly known as Saigon.

Upon arrival, leave for city's tour. Visit **Independence Palace**, also known as the **Reunification palace**, was built on the sight of the former Norodom palace. The Independence palace is a widely known landmark of Ho Chi Minh City and was designed by the architect Ngo Viet Thu. Continue seeing the beautiful structures from the French Colonial times such as **the Notre Dame Cathedral**, the historic **Central Post Office**.

DAY 7:

Ho Chi Minh - Cu Chi Tunnels - Walking Street (B)

Post Breakfast, visit the **Cu Chi Tunnel**. This fantastic network stretches over 250 kms and is the shelter of Vietnamese soldiers during the wars. The system was served as communication routes, storage facilities, hospitals and living areas for Vietnamese warriors to fight US Military during the Vietnamese War.

Take your time to **descend into the tunnels** to see how the VietCong survived in the harsh conditions. Get the opportunity to **fire real AK-47s**/M16s and other weapons in a shooting range.

Relax post your day long outing. In the night, visit the Bui Vien Street, Shop till you drop and party like the locals do! Try out the region's famous Bahn Mi and Pho. Saigon's beer street has some great places to party too. Have a taste of Bia Saigon, the city's local beer.

Experience nightlife of Vietnam.


